



2017 Site Specific Milfoil Report: Grapevine Cove

In 2017, we pulled 22 gallons of milfoil from Grapevine Cove. We have successfully controlled milfoil in this area over the past four years. In 2013, we pulled 549.5 gallons of milfoil from Grapevine. We have not pulled more than 25 gallons in a single year since 2013, which attests to the efficacy of our removal practices and encourages us when tackling large infestations found in the Squam River. The milfoil plants we now find in Grapevine are small and isolated. Residents of Grapevine Cove played a crucial role in our removal efforts. We trained Grapevine Cove residents to be Weed Watchers, and they were able to regularly check the cove for milfoil and report any suspicious plants. Looking into 2018, we will continue regularly surveying this area and expect plant regrowth to be minimal.
