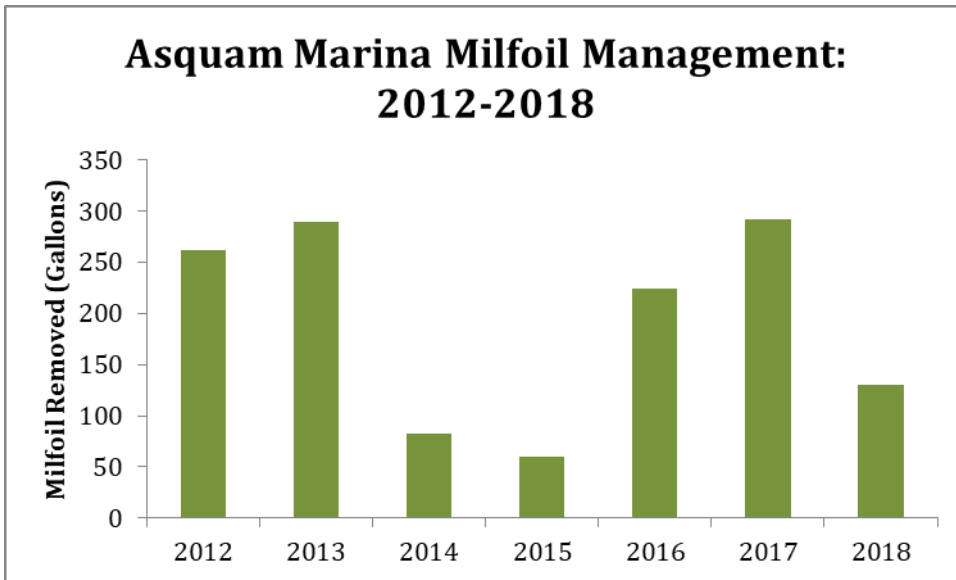




Squam Lakes Watershed 2018 Milfoil Report: Asquam Marina/ Holderness Harbor

In Asquam Marina, there was less milfoil growth in 2018 compared to 2017. We removed 130 gallons of milfoil from Asquam Marina in 2018. The dense native population of plants makes finding and removing small patches of invasive milfoil difficult. In order to reduce growth, we continuously returned to survey for and hand pull variable milfoil. In 2019, we will continue these management practices to remove seasonal growth.
