At Home Activity

Step 1: Look at the “Birds of New England” presentation on the SLA website. For each slide, you will see that there is a link to a bird call at the bottom of the screen. Read through the slides and listen to each of the bird calls.

Step 2: Go into your backyard or another safe outdoor location and sit and listen. You can go by yourself or you can go with friends or family. Can you hear any birds? How many different songs or calls do you hear? Count the different sounds. Can you identify any of the sounds that you hear? (You’ll be lucky if you hear a crow because they’re easy.) If you have a pair of binoculars, bring them along and see if you can spot any of the birds that you hear. Happy birding!
